

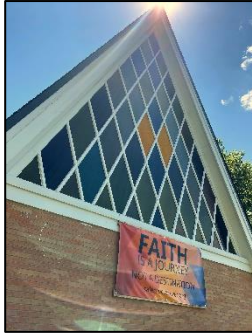

A Word From Pastor Russ



Whenever I prepare to write this monthly newsletter article, I usually begin by stopping. I take a moment to let everything settle, and then feel my way through the creation process. I engage my spiritual journey, my pastoral journey, scriptures I've read, news and other stories

I've read, and where I am sensing that we as a church community are. In the combination of all this, I listen for what it is I believe God calls me to say here on this page. As I prepared to write this article, I stopped. I took a moment for everything to settle, and then I tried to feel my way through.

And there was nothing. Zero.

Not in a writer's block sort of way, but in a burned-out sort of way. There simply was nothing there.

I realized that this has been the extent of my personal exhaustion. I answered a new call to this church in October 2019. Then I answered a new call to this church in March 2020 when the pandemic shut us down. I became a televangelist and a tele-minister overnight, so it was like starting a new church from scratch.

All this has taken a deep toll on my soul. I'm fortunate to have made it this far, and I've no doubt that's because of the loving, caring, and understanding people of Salem UCC. I am grateful. But I am tired. I'm chronically exhausted. I need a break. Starting August 1, I will be taking a 6-week leave of absence to work on healing my soul and refreshing my spirit. I have hard work to recover from burnout. I'll be journaling frequently and engaging in regular counseling deal with anxiety and depression from the past year. I will also do fun stuff to lighten my soul. And with the help of the Rocky Mountain Conference's Rev. Dr. Anthony Scott as a loving mediator, Salem will have the opportunity to begin the work of engaging the wear and tear of the pandemic on our congregation, as well as dealing with some longtime struggles.

We all need a break sometimes. After creating the world in 6 days, God rested on the 7th (Genesis 2:1-3). The prophet Elijah—on the run from Jezebel after his prophecies offended her—was told by God to take a break (1 Kings 19:3-9). Jesus often went away to rest and pray during his ministry (Matthew 14:23, Luke 6:12, Luke 22:41, Mark 6:31-32, Mark 7:24). These times have been hard on us all, and rest and recuperation—for pastors and for congregations and for all people—is good for our souls. I'll miss you these next 6 weeks, but will keep you, my beloved church, in prayer. Please keep me in prayer, too. May we all rest, recuperate, and—like the story of Elijah in 1 Kings 19—may we all find and reconnect with God. I'll see you in September!
