A Word From Pastor Russ

One of the beautiful aspects of Christmas during a pandemic is that it challenges us to rethink things. It pushes us to rethink our priorities by making us realize what really is most important in our lives: relationships with family, friends and God.

Or so I thought. The other day—It is still November as I write this—I went to a big box store, and was floored. The entire, gigantic Christmas section was gutted to the size it normally is in January, but without “Clearance” signs. People had bought out all that Christmas stuff, even before December!

Back in WWII when supplies got tight, people in the U.S. rationed, went to work to help the war effort, and bought bonds to support the troops. Today when there's a world crisis, people respond by buying copious stuff... most of which they don't need (1,000 rolls of toilet paper anyone?). And now COVID-weary people want to celebrate something—anything—so badly that the Christmas decorations they already have aren't enough—so they clear out the stores before December.


