But then I had to write my annual report for Salem, and I was forced to look back. So I did. And wow... Just wow.

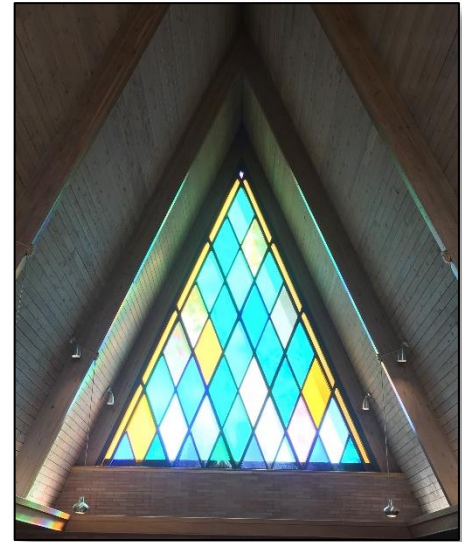

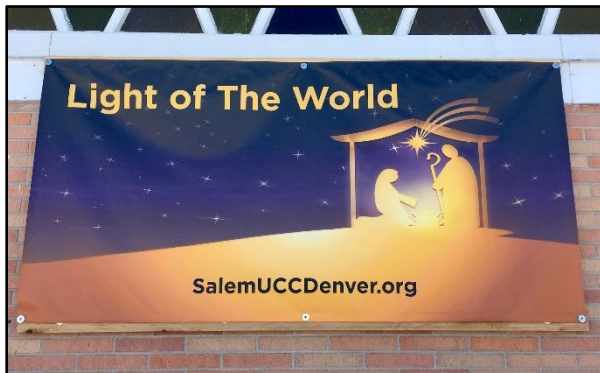


Moderator Moments

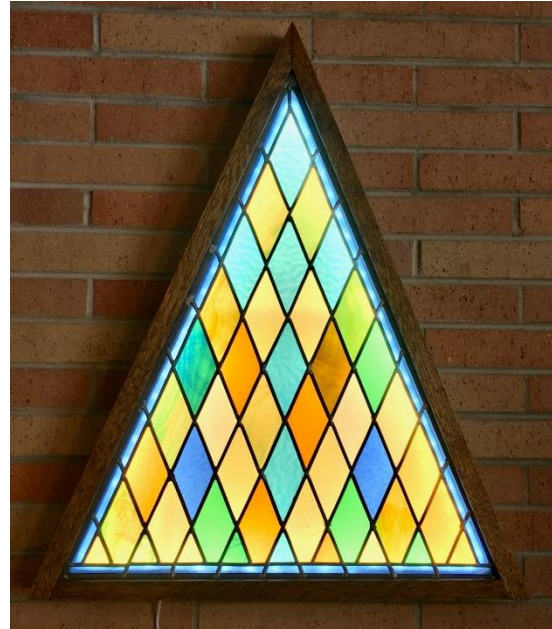

Salem Annual Meeting January 24

Salem UCC will hold its Annual Meeting event via Zoom on Sunday, January 24, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. following our worship service. The meeting will be recorded so that a full record of the meeting will be available in the future. Discussion and votes will be taken via Zoom. Because Salem's Covid-19 pandemic task force believes it is not safe for persons to meet in person because of federal, state and local guidelines, a second meeting will be held at a time when we can all be together. This will be done because there could be legal questions as to the validity of a meeting held virtually. Despite that, Salem needs to be able to move forward into the new year with our budget, new ministry council and committee members, officials, etc. The second meeting will be held to ratify or modify actions taken at the virtual meeting. Please note that the Annual Reports will be ready for distribution on Tuesday, January 12, and will be sent via email or postal mail (according to how newsletters are currently distributed). Please, read the reports and information prior to January 24 and be well prepared for our lively discussion.

Looking Ahead to 2021 Missions

Salem's 2021 missions will be a bit different. Since the first 5-6 month's Worship service will be held virtually, we will start with the first 5 months of missions.

Jan. - The Gathering Place - this organization has served women of poverty/homelessness for 7-20 years.

Feb. - Women's Bean Project. Hold your own "Souper Bowl Sunday" with their products from the grocery store and give a monetary donation through Salem.

Mar. - Food drive for Archway and Fish food banks as well as the UCC 5 for 5 One Great Hour of Sharing.

April - Pastor's Discretionary Fund in anticipation of our reopening in June!

May - 5 for 5 Strength the Church and Clothing collection for the new Archway Clothing Store.

June - Dec. missions will be determined by the Status of the virus and our ability to gather for Worship together. If you have ideas for the remaining missions please let June Seppa know!


