A Word From Pastor Russ

It's Lent again, and it will be our second Lent during this pandemic. It's hard to believe this month will mark a full year since we last gathered together for worship in our sanctuary.

When we last worshipped in person, Betty Black sang and prayed with us, now she and other Salem friends are no longer around. Hard to believe. We have new church members who have *only* worshipped with us online, and never in person. Also hard to believe.

When we last worshipped in person, we had no idea that in a few months, racial tensions would boil over and protests would erupt around the country, including here in Denver, protests that looked a lot like those of the Civil Rights movement in the 60s, and for much the same reason.

When we last worshipped in person, thousands upon thousands of acres of wilderness here, in California and across the western US had not yet burned and turned our skies black. We had no idea that we would be wearing masks and social distancing even now and beyond now. We also had no idea that that people would riot in our nation's capital, break into the building and urinate and defecate in its hallowed halls while yelling for the deaths of Republican and Democratic leaders.

It's been a whole year since last Lent, and more history has been made in the past year than in some past decades. It's hard to believe...

But Lent is a time for reflection, and looking back like this is part and parcel for this season. Some of us take on a Lenten discipline—something we give up or add to our lives to remind us of Christ in the time between Ash Wednesday and Easter, and we do this to remember and reflect...

Remember on those we've lost.

Reflect on all that's taken place.

Remember who we were back then; reflect on how much we've grown since.

Remember the lessons we've learned in the past year.

Reflect on the journey of Christ: a journey filled with lessons and loss, growth and change; a journey not unlike our own.

I invite you this Lent to do just that: reflect and remember. Take time out regularly between now and Easter to contemplate your spirit and where the Holy Spirit has brought your spirit. Each Sunday in Lent we will be exploring "Spirit and Soul," looking at our spirituality and the ways we are a spiritual people. It's a great opportunity to look inward and forward as we also look back. Join us in worship as we discover our spirituality, and invite a friend, too.
