

Addendum B - Volleyball Uniform Policy

The official uniform of the TASO-Volleyball shall be:

- A. The TASO-Volleyball official uniform shall only be worn to matches assigned by an authorized chapter assigner
- B. White and gray are approved colors for uniform shirts, jackets/sweatshirts, and undershirts. When any combination of shirts, jackets/sweatshirts, and undershirts are worn they must match colors. It is not necessary for both officials to have jackets or undershirts; however, they must still match colors (If a host school provides pink shirts for the officials during the month of October to support Breast Cancer Awareness, they may wear them for the match)
 - a. TASO-Volleyball collared short or long-sleeved shirts and sweatshirts/jackets must be purchased from an authorized TASO vendor
 - b. White is the default uniform color (No chapter will have the authority to mandate its members to purchase the gray uniform shirt/jacket)
 - c. Sweatshirts are only authorized in white
 - d. If worn, the approved full-zippered jacket must be fully fastened
 - e. The jacket/sweatshirt must be worn over the approved uniform shirt
 - f. Sweatshirt and/or full zippered jacket shall not be worn tucked in
 - g. Uniform shirts must be tucked into uniform pants
 - h. If an undershirt is worn, the sleeves should not extend below the uniform sleeve

C. Jet-black dress slacks

- a. A plain black belt must be worn with slacks that have belt loops
- b. In consideration of those members who do not wear pants due to religious beliefs, a jet-black skirt (length should be below the knee) may be worn
- c. Jet-black dress shorts may be worn in non-air-conditioned gyms only
 - 1. The length of the shorts shall be from the mid-thigh to the top of the knee
 - 2. If shorts are worn, black shoes and black socks are still required
 - 3. After district play ends, for playoffs, no shorts may be worn
- d. No culottes, capri pants, or fleece sweat slacks/shorts are to be worn
- D. Solid black athletic shoes, without any colored logo (Shoelaces must be black)
- E. Solid black socks should be visible, without logo
- F. A black whistle with a solid black lanyard (A pink whistle and pink lanyard may be worn during the month of October to support Breast Cancer Awareness)
- G. Cell phones are not part of the TASO-Volleyball uniform and should not be carried on the official's person (Smart watches should be used as a timing device only)
- H. The 50-year service pin and the Texas Way pin, both awarded by TASO-Volleyball, may be worn on the official's uniform on the left corner of the polo shirt collar (These are the only adornments allowed on the TASO official's uniform)
- I. Violations
 - a. Members found in violation of the official uniform policy will be penalized as follows:
 - 1. 1st Offense: Warning
 2. 2nd Offense: \$5 Fine
 - 3. 3rd Offense: \$25 Fine
 - b. Chapters should report all violations of the Uniform Policy to the TASO Office by emailing volleyball@taso.org
 - c. For subsequent violations the member will be considered a member not in good standing, and may be referred to as a TASO Policies and Procedures violation
