Apartment builder Palladium USA has started construction on its fifth affordable rental community for 2021 — this one in Garland.

The 107-unit mixed-income apartment project, Embree Eastside by Palladium, is being built at 536 Davidson Drive, east of downtown.

The \$26 million rental project will include units set aside for residents earning between 30% and 60% of the community's median income.

"Construction has started, and we will be delivering the clubhouse and first units in January of 2023," Tom Huth, president and CEO of Palladium USA, said in a statement.

Architect HEDK designed the three-story apartment complex, which will include a resort-style pool, a dog park, trails, a conference room, a computer lab, a kids' playroom and a fitness center.

Brownstone Construction is the general contractor and is partnering with the Garland Housing Finance Corp. on construction.
