Coached or Leadline Obstacle <i>Open to riders ages 10 and under who cannot ride without assistance. Must be led at all times. Can not cross enter in any other class.</i>	Novice Rider Arena Obstacles <i>Open to any age rider in their first year of competing trail. Entries may not cross enter on open trail.</i>
Novice Horse Arena Obstacles <i>Open to any horse or pony in their first year of competing trail. Entries may not cross enter in open trail</i>	Youth Open Arena Obstacles <i>Open to riders ages 17 and under. Entries may not cross enter in novice.</i>
Adult Open Arena Obstacles <i>Open to riders ages 18 and older. Entries may not cross enter in novice</i>

Incomplete entries may be placed on a waiting list. **No entries will be accepted without payment in full.** Late entries MAY be accepted at the Show Secretary's discretion. Scratches prior to closing date will receive a full refund. After closing date, NO refunds will be given.

Directions to HCE: 2965 Hat Creek Road, Brookneal, VA 24528
US-460 E to Lynchburg, take the US-29 S exit toward Danville, turn left onto Calohan Road, continue straight onto Wisecarver Road, turn right onto US-501 S, turn left onto Winfall Road, turn right onto Red House Road, slight right onto Morris Church Road, right onto Hat Creek Road, right onto Hurt Road, follow signs for Horse Show Parking on left. Do not turn onto Hurt from Irving. **NOTE** if you are following GPS do not turn onto Hurt from Irving Dale. Dangerous bridge. Only turn onto to Hurt from Hat Creek.

Other information: There will be no practicing of courses! We want this fair for all. First judged rider is 10 am and last judged rider is at 1pm. Show up between those times to compete. Anyone that shows up after 1pm will not be able to compete. People are to stay off the trails. If you need to lunge or warm-up we have a large round pen and open arena you're welcome to use. No warming up in parking areas since horses will be tied and children will be on the loose. No horses are permitted past the round pen area. We will keep our barn area closed and ask folks coming in not to take your horses over to our paddocks where our boarders and program horses are. No alcohol or drugs on our property. Please put trash in our trash cans. This helps us so much. The horses here also appreciate it! No dogs or stallions allowed on the property. You get 3 attempts per obstacle. If you fail to complete obstacle you get a 0 score. You must attempt all obstacles to get a final score to qualify for a placing. If you complete it correctly you get a score for that obstacle. Approved helmets required for youth riders while mounted and encouraged for in-hand and adults.
