- Launching multiplying entrepreneurship training with 25+ participants from 5 organizations.
- Seeding new microloan groups for sustainable business growth.
- Lifting the burden off of us so we can focus on partnerships and expansion
- Living out our mission: encourage and equip others to fulfill their God-given dreams.

One Story, A Growing Ripple

MEET EUNICE — JUST ONE EXAMPLE OF THE FRUIT.

"Before the training, I was drowning in debt. I could barely make ends meet. I didn't even know how to calculate profit."

She joined a training hosted through her self-help group, where our Uganda staff led sessions on business planning, marketing, and financial literacy.

Tlearned how to separate personal and business finances, reinvest profits, and delay spending on things I didn't need."

With just \$55, she relaunched her green grocery stand. She now tracks income, pays off debt, and teaches her kids what she's learned.
