Preschool Newsletter

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Well, the holidays are over, and its back to preschool business and that includes registration for the 2025-2026 school year. Here are a few important points to remember about the registration process for the next school year:

1. Preschool registration for children currently enrolled in our program will begin **on Jan. 21st** Registration forms will go home on Jan. 16th and 17th with the children currently enrolled in the 3-year-old classes and those who've let me know they need 5-year-old and/or sibling packets. A cover letter will be attached to each registration form explaining the registration procedure. **If you have a preschooler that is currently in our 4-year-old program and wish to enroll them in our 5-year-old program, please notify me so I can send a registration form home with your child.**
2. Everyone currently enrolled in our 3-year-old program is guaranteed a place in a program for next school year, but we cannot guarantee your first choice selection. For example, if 20 parents request the 3-day morning session for 4-year-olds and there are only 17 openings, we will hold a lottery for that class session. The parents that did not get their first choice will automatically get their second choice.
3. All registration forms must be accompanied by a registration check of \$85.00 made out to SASEAS Preschool. All tuition and medical forms should be up-to-date to register for the 2025-2026 school year.
4. Parents of preschool siblings who wish to register for next school year can notify me by phone (513) 575-9900, or email limberga@saseas.org so I can send a form home.
5. If your preschooler has a summer birthday, or has become ineligible for Kindergarten due to the new cutoff date of August 15, consider enrolling them in our Pre-K class for 5-year-olds. Please contact your child's preschool teacher and/or our Pre- K teacher, Mrs. Liz, if you have any concerns or would like to observe a Pre-K class. All of our staff are certified by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services to teach preschool age children in Ohio. Any recommendation made by your child's teacher concerning your child's readiness skills is based on observations in the classroom, working with your child, and evaluations of readiness skills mandated by the state curriculum.

Please contact me if you have any questions regarding registration for the next school year. Again, thank you for all you do to support our preschool program. I wish you and your families a safe, healthy, and blessed 2025.
