




January 2024 Highlights

- Completed year long in-depth Ambulance Cost Data Collection Survey through Medicare




February 2024 Highlights

- Kansas City Chiefs were victorious in overtime at Super Bowl LVIII




March 2024 Highlights

- A container ship struck the Francis Scott Key Bridge in Baltimore causing a partial collapse killing six persons




April 2024 Highlights

- Mexico elects first female president






July 2024 Highlights

- Presidential candidate Donald Trump shot while attending rally in Butler, PA




August 2024 Highlights


September 2024 Highlights

- Hurricane Helene batters southwestern US killing more than 230 people and causing tens of billions of dollars in property damage.





November 2024 Highlights


- Trumbull and Sharon Hospitals announced closures after financial woes

 President Kamala Harris and becoming only the second president ever elected to serve non-consecutive terms.




December 2024 Highlights


HARTFORD TOWNSHIP RESPONSES 2024




