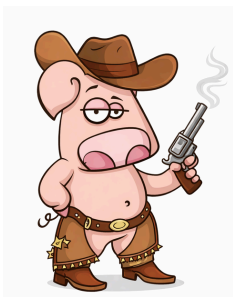

This is a friendly competition and decisions by the Pickelball Committee are final. We expect the honor system for score-keeping of all teams. By signing above, you agree to the rules and requirements.

PICKLEBALL RULES

- All serves must be performed underhand with contact to the ball made below the waist.
- All serves must be made into the opposite diagonal service area. Failure to do so will result in a fault.
- Players are only allowed one attempted serve.
- To begin the game, only one player from the initial serving team is granted a service turn. For the rest of the match, both members will have a service turn before giving up the ball to their opponents.
- The server will continue to alternate sides of the court they serve from until they lose a point.
- Matches are played best of 3 games. Youth Division games will be played to 7 and Competitive Division games will be played to 11 points. Must win by 2.
- Both teams must play their first shot of a rally off the bounce. This is the Double Bounce Rule. Once both have done so successfully... OPA! And volleys are now fair game.
- No player is allowed in The Kitchen or Non-Volley Zone unless the ball has already bounced on their side of the court. This includes a player landing in the area following a volley.
- Only one bounce is permitted on the same side of the court. Once two bounces occur, the team that hits the shot wins the point.
- No rally scoring. Only the serving team can score.
- When keeping score [Serving Team's Score - Receiving Team's Score - Service Turn]
- The receiving team never changes sides in the game of pickleball.
- To help keep things running smoothly, the committee may set a time limit if needed.
