

Ordinance # 153 GO

An Ordinance Prohibiting Hoofed Animals within the city limits of Grainfield, repealing ordinances 32 GO, 73 GO, 152 GO and all other ordinances in conflict with this ordinance.

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Grainfield, Kansas

Section 1. No person shall keep, hold or maintain hoofed animals within the city limits of Grainfield, Kansas, with the exceptions as set forth in Section 2.

Section 2. Exceptions

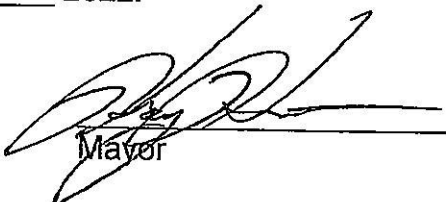
(A) The Gove County Fair Grounds area, bounded on south by the north side of Third Street, bounded on the east by Cleveland Avenue, bounded on the west by the west Grainfield City limits, bounded on the north by a line one hundred feet south of and running parallel to the south side of Fifth Street. The Gove County Fair Grounds shall be an area used as a temporary facility for animals.

(B) The area south of Highway 23 shall be exempt.

Section 3. Persons or entities violating the provisions of the ordinance shall be guilty of a code violation subject to a fine of up to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each day of violation.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
