

Lakeside Booster Club Meeting Minutes

September 2, 2026

Meeting called to order by Kelsey at 6:00

- Financials were reviewed and approved
- Money minder update- Quickbooks is transferred over, more detail will be included in MM
- Grandparent's banner had 25 kids sign up and made \$1,450
- Sponsor update, we have 21 sponsors (goal was 10) for a total of \$18,250
- Tax-exempt application has been approved
- Gambling application is almost complete
- Swag sales at Mercantile are going well, made \$173 in August
- Concession stand is complete! Sign honoring the Robison Family was damaged but new one is on the way
- LMS will use the concession stand for track and football, giving them 20% is approved
- Coach appreciation used to be dinner, using those funds towards gifts for coaches is approved
- Gold cards won't be sold by football this year, instead we will sell at concessions, Boosters will make \$15 for each card and only pay for what is sold
- Update on community funds for fire victims, \$6,200 has been donated with 24 applications received
- Booster website is up and running with mission statement posted
- Boosters is starting a page on Band, inviting all the coaches and parents
- Sending survey for parent engagement
- Board members to get food handler's licenses
- Kelsey is meeting with ASB 9.10 to discuss what their group does and needs they may have
- Senior banners will have a \$35 fee this year & donor funds that used to cover the banners will go towards school projects. Boosters will cover the fee for kids in need
- Fall Festival is Sunday 10.4 from 1-4 at Stonelodge. Tickets will be sold that include a meal, drink and donut. There will be an early bird discount for people that pre-purchase

-Future fundraising event ideas are a winter festival (and possibly Christmas tree removal) and spring plant bingo for Mother's Day

-Kids that volunteer at Booster events will get free meals

-Track needs new wind screen banners to replace the damaged and missing, the cost is \$2,300

-Homecoming fireworks costs will be split 3 ways, booster paying \$500 is approved

-September 15th Inland Power is attending volleyball & giving away \$5 concessions gift cards to students and will reimburse school for those redeemed
