

SINGLE-ENGINE COMMERCIAL PILOT TRAINING COST

Based on FAA 250 hr minimum; Normal rates apply

- 160 hrs of time building
 - Aircraft C172 - \$110 (160 x \$110) = \$21
- 10 Hrs dual = \$2,200
 - Aircraft C177B- \$140 hr (10 hrs x \$140) = \$1,400
 - Flight Instruction - \$50 hr (10 hrs x \$50) = \$500
 - Ground Instruction - \$40 hr (.3 x 25 hrs x \$40) = \$300
- 10 hrs ground training = \$400
 - Ground Instruction - \$40 hr (10 x \$40) = \$400
- Flight Training Materials = \$1,084.9
 - Commercial Pilot Kit - \$144.95
 - Ground School - \$164.95
 - Knowledge test - \$175 (approx.)
 - Checkride - \$600 (approx.)

Total estimated cost: \$25,809.90

*All prices are based on normal rates and on the FAA's 40 hr minimum requirement. Additional instruction may be necessary, based on student's progression within the program
