

## INSTRUMENT RATING TRAINING COST

Based on the FAA 40 hr minimum; Normal rates apply

- 15 Hrs dual = \$3,300
- o Aircraft C177B \$150 hr (15 hrs x \$150) = \$2,250
- o Flight Instruction \$50 hr (15 hrs x \$50) = \$750
- o Ground Instruction \$40 hr  $(.3 \times 25 \text{ hrs } \times $40) = $300$
- 10 hrs BATD Flight Simulator/Ground training = \$800
- o BATD Flight Simulator \$40 hrs (10 hrs  $\times$  \$40) = \$400
- o Ground Instruction \$40 hr  $(10 \times $40) = $400$
- 15 hrs Simulated/Actual flight time = \$2,250

o Aircraft C177B - \$150 hr (15 hrs x \$150) = \$2,250

- 10 hrs ground training = \$400
- o Ground Instruction \$40 hr (10 x \$40) = \$400
- Flight Training Materials = \$ 1,275
- o Instrument Kit \$200
- o Ground School \$200
- o Knowledge test \$175 (approx.)
- o Checkride \$700 (approx.)

## **Total estimated cost: \$8,025**
