

MULTI-ENGINE COMMERCIAL PILOT TRAINING COST

This is a fly-to-proficiency rating, no hour requirement per FAA regulations is required

• 10 Hrs dual = \$4,400

o Aircraft Piper Seneca I- \$300 hr (10 hrs x \$300) = \$3,000

o Flight Instruction - \$60 hr (10 hrs x \$60) = \$600

o Ground Instruction - \$40 hr (20 hrs x \$40) = \$800

Checkride Cost: \$1,000

Total estimated cost: \$5,400

*All prices are based on normal rates

*10 Hrs is the average number of hours FFIA students obtain their Multi-Engine Commercial Rating
