

SINGLE-ENGINE COMMERCIAL PILOT TRAINING COST

Based on FAA 250 hr minimum; Normal rates apply

• 160 hrs of time building = \$20,800

o Aircraft C172 - \$130 (160 x \$130) = \$20,800

• 10 Hrs dual = \$2,350

o Aircraft C177B- \$155 hr (10 hrs x \$155) = \$1,550

o Flight Instruction - \$50 hr (10 hrs x \$50) = \$500

o Ground Instruction - \$40 hr (.3 x 25 hrs x \$40) = \$300

• 10 hrs ground training = \$400

o Ground Instruction - \$40 hr (10 x \$40) = \$400

Flight Training Materials = \$1,305

o Commercial Pilot Kit - \$150

o Ground School - \$180

o Knowledge test - \$175 (approx.)

o Checkride - \$800 (approx.)

Total estimated cost: \$24,855
