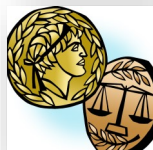

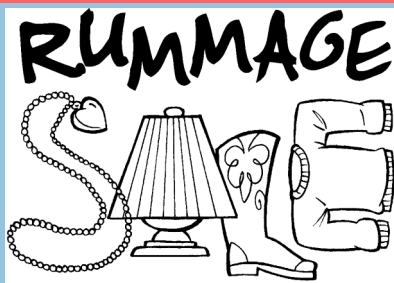

IN—PERSON WORSHIPS

Dear FIRST Family, With lots of prayer and council discussion, most of you already know we are moving our worship services back indoors with the outdoors option as well. Moving forward and unless CDC says otherwise, we will be having indoors worships from now on.

This comes after lots of hard work from council, staff, and most importantly our voluntary members who got together to facilitate a setting that is safe for everyone. Together we are committed to keeping people safe and Living the Love of Christ in all that we do. We will still be holding our online streaming live.

Our indoor service will be held in the sanctuary. Half of it will be for first service and the other half for second service to avoid sanitizing pews in-between. We have blocked some of the pews and set up ribbon and hymnals to make sure we are practicing the 6 feet of social distance.

As you come to worship, ushers will greet you and help everyone safely enter with a temperature check and help you find a seat, similar to the way we have been proceeding in our outdoor worships. A mask is required as well as appropriate social distancing before, during and after each service. We have enough space, given the state guidelines, to seat up to 100 individuals but for the moment we are only allowing 40 individuals at each service. It will be first come first serve so please go register now. The indoor service itself will be a little different than in the past. There will be no childcare and no chapel time for the time being.

You can give your offering through our App, website, by mail or when you come to worship in person. We strongly suggest you sign-up on our online giving as you are able.

Come and enjoy a Word and Sacrament worship.

We can't wait to see you there.

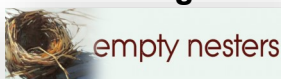

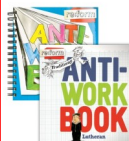
DONATE A PUMPKIN For our Noah's Ark Families

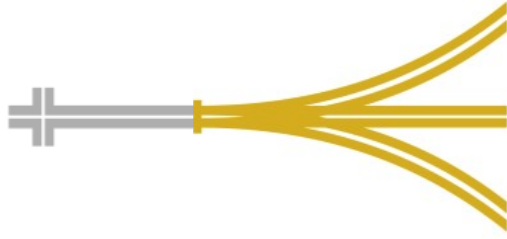
Healthy Start: 7th 6:30-8:30 **Bat Week:** We will learn about the benefits of having them in our environment.
