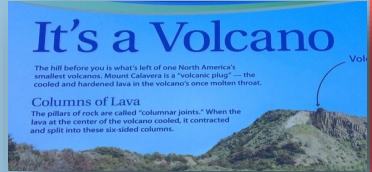
FAMILY FUN — CALAVERA HIKE

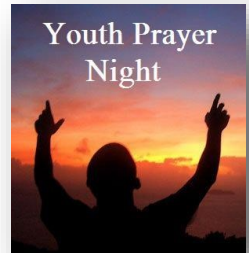

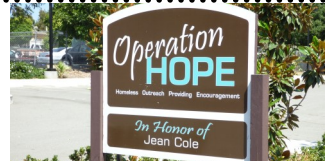

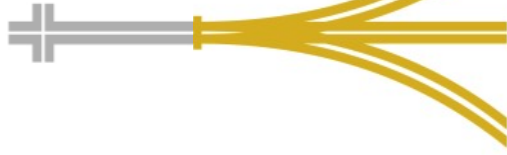
