- Masks will be required at all times, except for children 2 years and under.
- No nursery and Sunday School will be provided during COVID-19.
- Please maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet from people not in your household.
- Bring any supplies you might need to survive a 30-45 min outdoor worship service!
 - Water, hats, sunscreen, umbrellas, hand sanitizer, and Kleenex.
- There will be one entry point in front of the church. Exits will be located between the Community Room and Trinity Center. Please follow the arrows.
- Ushers will guide you to your seating area. Once you are seated, please refrain from leaving your seating area. Ushers will come and dismiss you when worship has concluded.
- First Service will be sitting between the Fellowship Room and the Sanctuary's sliding door. The second Service will be seated between the Office and Sanctuary's sliding door.
- Please refrain from using the bathroom if possible. The bathroom will be available for one person to use at a time. The main door will be open and please keep it that way to avoid touching the handle and maintain fresh airflow.
