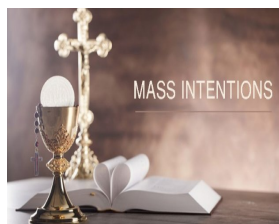

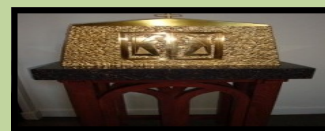

**ANOINTING MASS OF THE SICK/
MISA DE UNCIÓN DE LOS ENFERMOS
TUESDAY, DECEMBER 9, 2025, 11:00 A.M.**

Through the apostle James, Jesus instructs: *"Are any among you sick? Let them call for the priests of the Church, who will pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord. The prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise them up; their sins will be forgiven."* This sacrament is offered to Catholics facing serious physical ailments, undergoing major surgery, the elderly weakened by age, those battling serious illnesses, and seriously ill children of reason age. The community is called to pray for and support those in need.

A través de Santiago, Jesús nos manda: *"¿Hay algún enfermo entre ustedes? 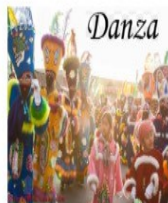

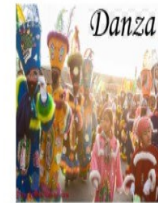
