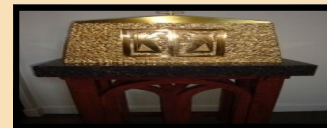

GOSPEL MEDITATION

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

June 7, 2026

John 6:51-58

As a young altar server, I once heard someone ask, "Is Father distributing the bread or the wine?" Later, another person asked, "Can you get Jesus from the tabernacle?" Those very different ways of speaking left me confused. Is it just bread, or is it Jesus? On this Feast of Corpus Christi, Jesus' words in the Gospel help us: "My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink" (John 6:55). Some dismiss these words as symbolic, while others misunderstand them entirely. Both miss the truth. The Church gives us language that reflects this mystery. After the consecration, we speak of the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Christ, the Real Presence, and the Most Blessed Sacrament. These words safeguard the truth that Christ is truly present under the appearances of bread and wine. When we speak rightly about the Eucharist, we believe more deeply and adore more fully the One who gives himself to us: Jesus Christ, whole and entire.
