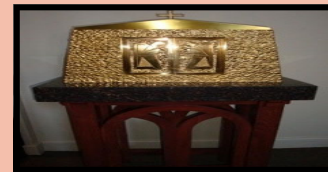

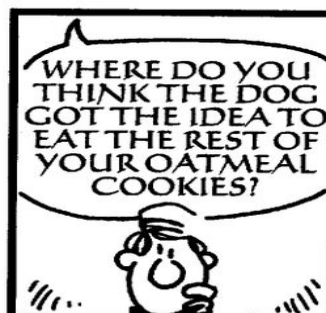

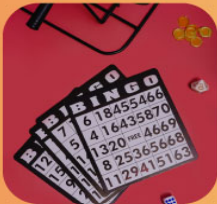

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

October 12, 2025

28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Luke 17:11-19

Dorothy Day, the great Catholic activist, once doubted God’s existence. But after giving birth to her daughter, she was overwhelmed with gratitude. Holding her child, she realized she had done nothing to deserve such a miraculous gift — only to be flooded by love for the Giver. In Luke 17:19, Jesus tells a healed leper, “Stand up and go; your faith has saved you.” His deeper healing came not just from faith, but from returning to give thanks. Like Dorothy, his gratitude opened the way to encounter God himself. Gratitude has that same power for us. It frees us from sadness and self-pity, turning our eyes from what we lack to what we’ve received. We learn this at Mass, where the priest prays, “It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks.” Gratitude is not just a feeling—it’s an act of faith. In the Eucharist, Christ gives everything for us, and in our thanksgiving, we are healed.
