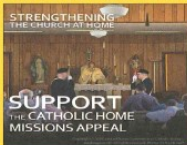
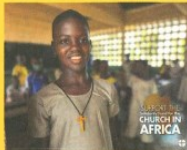


Church in Latin America

St. Frances Xavier Cabrini Catholic Church is seeking a dependable Part-Time Custodian to help maintain our church and parish facilities.

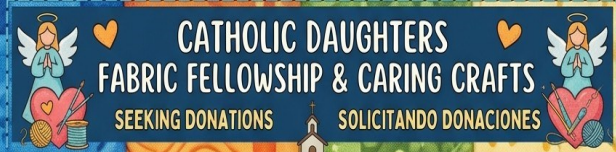
