# **GRAPES**

70% Sangiovese, 15% Merlot, 15% Pollera Nera

# THE WINE

The nose is intense and harmonious, with spicy notes of black pepper, and cinnamon. The mouth is warm and persistent; the sensations perceived in the bouquet are enhanced by ripe fruit and wild berries, while good minerality ensures a long, dry finish.

#### **POLLERA NERA**

This native grape adds freshness and great character

#### **SANGIOVESE**

Provides the structure, strength and just the right note of tannin

## **MERLOT**

Provides the fruit and softness to the wine

# **DECANTER 2022**

**SILVER, 92 POINTS** 

A sweet and sour nose with dried herb and menthol hints. Fresh red and black cherry dominate the palate, with delicious lifted dried tea savoury hints, lovely texture to the tannin and a long dry finish.

Niccolo'V (Nicholas the fifth) was a very important Pope born in Sarzana in 1397. On the 600th anniversary of his birth, in 1997, Paolo Bosoni, owner and winemaker for Cantine Lunae, created this wine in his honour.

Niccolo' V was an important Renaissance Pope, known for his love of the arts and literature. Beginning in his student days, Nicholas had accumulated manuscripts and achieved a reputation as a collector even before his elevation to pope. His personal library consisted of 807 manuscripts in Latin and 353 in Greek. After his death, this collection became the foundation for the Vatican Library.

Paolo named this wine after Niccolo'V as he was reported to love wine, women, and song!
