ABV: 40% **Grape varieties:** Ugni Blanc, Folle Blanche, Colombar

Production: A fine selection of eaux-de-vie with Petite Champagne, Fins Bois and a touch of Borderies.

Aging: Eaux-de-vie up to 12 years old, reduction in four stages in Limousin oak barrels with a light toasting to retain the finesse of the Hardy style.

- ◆ **Nose:** citrus fruit, orange jam, cappuccino coffee with vanilla notes
- ◆ **Palate:** coffee, orange and orange jam
