Production: Fine Champagne, blend of two of the best terroirs in the Cognac region.

Aging: Eaux-de-vie up to 8 years old, reduction in four stages in Limousin oak barrels with a light toasting.

Notes from the cellar master

- ◆ Nose: fresh pear and vanilla
- ◆ Palate: walnut and cinnamon notes
- ◆ Finish: melt-in-the-mouth, well balanced
