A British gentleman, Anthony Hardy, founded Hardy cognac in 1863. Five generations later, the house of Hardy is still recognized for its premium quality cognacs and a smooth, lightly-oaked taste.

Technical information:

ABV: 40% **Grape varieties:** Ugni Blanc, Folle Blanche, Colombard

Production: Fine Champagne, blend of two of the best crus in the Cognac region.

Aging: Eaux-de-vie 15 to 25 years old, reduction in four stages in Limousin oak barrels with a light toasting.

- ◆ Finish: lingering aromas
