At Marrenon, we like these well-balanced expressions, where the impression of substance is very present. We seek to refine it as much as possible to create sensations in the mouth marked by softness and velvety.

We have sought to strengthen the expressions of the Syrah grapes which bring spicy notes with a touch of Mourvèdre, which reinforce and complex the traditional style of Grenache and its procession of very ripe fruits.

The historical vineyards of Marrenon have passed on to us a great passion for the Syrah and Grenache grape varieties on our magnificent limestone terroirs. The "Les Belles Echappées" collection reveals other expressions by exploring new terroirs of character.

The word "plan" for "plain" refers to the perfectly flat arrangement of the terrace, and the reference to God is probably due to the 7th century Carthusian monasteries of Prébayon and St. André, which gradually became owners of almost the entire area called "Plan de Dieu" ("Plain of God"). During this period, the region was "under the blessing of God". The monks held these lands until the Revolution. According to another legend of the Middle Ages, the travelers entrusted their souls to God before crossing this vast forest and scrubland with its predators...

This fairly uniform terroir is really a vast alluvial terrace formed by the Aigues and Ouvèze rivers during the Riss Glacial Period two or three hundred thousand years ago, overlaid with chalky gravel dating from the Quaternary Era. The gravel mainly rests on zaffre sandstone. The soil is unique with a strong terroir uniformity. This beautiful alluvial terrace is clearly defined and endlessly exposed to the powerful Mistral wind.

Grenache noir 60%, Syrah 30%, Mourvèdre 10%

Alcohol content: 15 ABV

Contains sulphites. Does not contain egg or egg products. Does not contain milk or milk-based products.

Serve at 14°C. This red wine will perfectly accompany a gardiane of bull or a leg of lamb.
