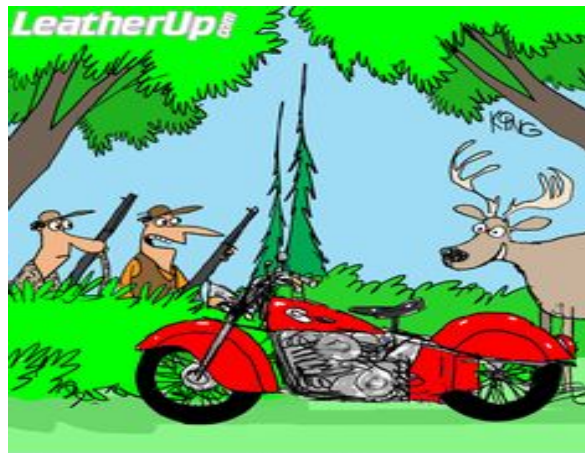

Live in God's Power and Authority!

*“By my power I will make my people strong,
and by my authority they will go wherever they wish.
I, the Lord, have spoken!”
(Zechariah 10:12 NLT)*

Zechariah 10 is a prophetic promise to the people of Israel during a time of restoration. After years of exile and oppression, God speaks through Zechariah to declare His intention to strengthen His people and lead them into freedom and purpose. This verse is a declaration of empowerment! God is going to restore His people and lead them into their destiny. DIVINE STRENGTH AND AUTHORITY OVERRIDE OUR HUMAN LIMITATIONS.

In a world obsessed with hustle, speed, and self-made success, we often feel the pressure to perform, to prove, and to push ourselves beyond our limits. But Zechariah's word offers you and I a counter-cultural truth: GOD IS THE SOURCE OF OUR TRUE STRENGTH AND DIRECTION. In a culture that glorifies independence, God invites us to depend on His divine authority that is found only in Him.

But God says, *“By MY power, I will make you strong.”* Not by your resume, your hustle, or your network of associates, but by His Spirit. The Living God doesn't just strengthen you to stand. He empowers you to go wherever He leads. It may be into new opportunities, deeper relationships, bolder decisions, and even unfamiliar territory. HIS AUTHORITY IS YOUR PASSPORT. HIS STRENGTH IS YOUR FUEL. So, pause and take a breath. Ask yourself: Where is God accelerating me today, not by force, but by faith? Live an accelerated life in Jesus Christ! Live wisely! Live opportunistically! Live with a sense of urgency! (Eph. 5: 15-17)
