MOMENTUM FOR LIVING

"Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends you and lead me along the path of everlasting life."

(Psalm 139:23-24 NLT)

David wrote Psalm 139, during a time when he lay under the reproach and slanderous accusations of men, who had made false accusations against him. King Saul was persecuting him and David's son, Absalom, was rebelling against him. David concludes his appeal of innocence before God by essentially asking God to peel back any layers of self-deception. Only then would David fully recognize the offenses he should confess and the burdens he needed to hand over to God. He wanted his offensive thoughts and ways brought to the surface so they could be dealt with, repented of, and purified from him. David makes a request for guidance and a desire to live in a way that is pleasing to God. His words are a powerful prayer for introspection, confession, repentance, and divine guidance. It reflects a heart that is open to correction and eager to align with God's will. Elsewhere in Scripture we find that David was a man after God's own heart (1 Samuel 13:14; Acts 13:22). Are you willing to pray that the God, who knows you, knows where you are, made you, and has a plan for you, will "search you and know you"? Are you ready to be changed according to God's will for your life? God designed you to have momentum.

"Heavenly Father, what comfort it is to know that You know everything about me. Even the things that I do wrong can never separate me from Your unfailing love. Jesus, lead me into peace and contentment. Holy Spirit, help me to live out this truth in my life, and may I do only those things that are pleasing in Your sight. In Jesus' name, I pray.
