The Rally is about HERE!!!! I hope everyone is excited about this as I am! With all the recent flooding please be mindful of those flooded areas and low water crossings. This goes for the motorcycles and our cars. You may know that crossing, drive it daily, the water may look like it's only a few inches deep. What you don't know is what is immediately under the surface. There may be debris, the pavement may be buckled, missing large chucks, or the road surface may be completely washed away! PLEASE FIND A DIFFERENT ROUTE!

Higher temps are here as well, keep yourself hydrated on the bike, make sure you are drinking plenty of fluids! Keep an eye out for your fellow riders when in a group, at stops if you see someone that is either sweating a lot or not at all, they seem confused or dizzy, or complaining of cramps, they may be suffering from heat stroke or exhaustion. Both of these are very serious!



ART Riding- Wil Wheelock

Finally, we have completed Level 1 of the Harley Owners Group Advanced Riding Techniques (ART). Completing this session required the riders to go outside of their comfort zone and try something new. For me change is always scary. I am proud of the riders who not only completed Level 1 but also of the riders that tried it, even once, and decided that new slow speed control techniques were not for them. Level 1 started out on focusing on straight up slow control. At the end it focused on making sharp turns and learning to lean the motorcycle.

Now we are moving onto Level 2. It will focus on leaning the bike, making very tight turns and making circles. This will be the hardest level to learn. So, it will take the longest time to learn. I would never call Level 1 or 2 fun. But they are necessary if you want to have total control of your bike and that is what this is all about. That control is what will make you a safer rider. At the completion of Level 2, training for the Hog ART will be complete. We will offer a Level 3 that will be a cone course and that should be a lot of fun. The course will be designed so that you can practice your new skills in a fun way and to build friendships with the other riders. Keep checking the calendar for upcoming practice times. We would love for you to participate!
