

Vehicle Storage Agreement

We offer several storage locations and arrangements depending on your needs and length of stay for your car, truck, boat, camper etc. Regardless of arrangements, all vehicles are stored completely at your risk. We do not hold any liability or other insurances that covers vehicles, boats, campers etc. (now referred to as 'UNIT or UNITS') of our clients. Insuring them as well as any contents is the responsibility of the owner of said unit. We make every attempt to ensure the security of the unit by keeping the storage area clean and maintained, and periodically inspected. We shall not be held liable or accountable for any damage or loss outside of our control. This includes, but is not limited to any act of God including weather, wind, hail, flood, earthquake, tornado, hurricanes, heavy snow/blizzards etc.. Loss or damage from fire, arson, building collapse, break-ins, vandalism, protest, riots, water intrusion etc. also is not covered in any way by Mair's Continental Motors, its employees or subcontractors. Your vehicle will likely be stored alongside our own collection of cars and boats, therefore we value the security of yours as much as ours. However, we must stress that you have a meaningful insurance policy in place for the unit for which we will be storing and provide a current copy of the insurance policy. Depending on the level of storage you request, we will show you the location prior to drop off. If at any time we would need to rearrange storage spots or move your unit to a different location, you will be notified with plenty of time before the move happens. Most storage arrangements are long term/limited access, meaning we prefer clients who do not need constant access to their units. Our indoor accommodations are accessed on a limited basis, by appointment only.
