## SHOW AND TELL by Bob Walker...

I brought in two 30 year old plus, RC transmitters to show. One is a Kraft Series 74 five channel radio. Phil Kraft, the company owner, was an RC aerobatic champion, designed RC planes and even flew aerobatics in full size aircraft. Each year, the manufacturers came out with something a little different, just like automobiles. Kraft was one of the top of the line radios in the sixties and seventies. Most started out at \$400 which was a lot in those days. No servo reversing or any other modern niceties. One had to be clever in an RC plane set up.

The second, in the black box is a single stick Orbit transmitter. Orbit was one of the first into proportional

radio control. Single stick transmitters are rare now a days, but at one time, 10-15% of the market was single stick. The rudder control is on the large knob. Yaw was achieved by twisting it right or left. There is even a rudder trim control in the very center. Many single stick transmitters had a throttle lever on the side, so one could cradle the transmitter and manipulate the throttle with the left fingers.

By the mid seventies, the Japanese slowly started making inroads into the US market. And by the eighties, almost all the radios manufactured were foreign made. Adjusted for inflation, those radios from 30 years ago should be selling for over \$1000 today. One was really dedicated to the hobby back then to spend \$300-\$600 for a radio. The transmitters were matched tuned to a specific receiver, so no going to the hobby shop to get an extra flight pack.
