The E-Flite Blade

Steve Pugh brought in a very nice looking Sig Citabria. It's powered with a Supertigre 51 and has a 65 inch wingspan.

Tom Obringer is getting into the helicopter scene. He showed us a very nice E-Flite Blade helicopter. He flew it very well. It's sold complete with a spectrum radio. Good deal.

THE GARY PROJECT...Ron Lazzeri

Gary Hershberger has been working on a most amazing project. He is reproducing a model of the Grumman F7F Tigercat. The F7F was developed for the Navy during 1941 as a heavy multi-role fighter. The first prototype appeared in December 1943. It's a twin engine aircraft with medium wing and a tricycle undercarriage. It was the first of its kind to see carrier-borne service with the Navy.

Gary started working on his 7F7 Tigercat in Fall of 2007. It is built from a Giant Scale Twins kit. It is 1/5 scale with a 118 inch

wingspan and weighing in at 45-52 lbs. The 7F7 is powered with two Zenoah G62 engines swinging 22x10 props. It has electric retracts, 6" main wheels and a 4" nose wheel. It is finished in fiberglass and painted with latex with a lacquer clear coat.

Estimated test flight for the Tigercat is late spring 2008.
