Steve and Jim Snyder's Incredible B-25

SHOW AND TELL...

It's here. After five years in gestation, The Snyder and Snyder Nostalgic Aircraft Fabrication Co. has come out with the gem of its RC modeling career. Jim and Steve have just completed a 101 inch, 32 lbs reproduction the North American B-25 bomber, one of the most famous airplanes to come out of WWII. They started this project in 2003: scroll down on archives button below, punch in "March 2003" and read about the start of their project and the significance of the B-25. You can also get a progress report by going to "December 2004".

The B-25 was scratch built from Zirolli plans. It is powered by two Fuji 32s. It's sheeted in balsa, covered with silkspan and painted with Nelson military paint. The guys made their own molds, did their own milling and prepared their own decals. This airplane is a real achievement. Everyone is waiting eagerly for its successful inauguration.
