- There was a request to bring a port-a-pot earlier this season. Steve Snyder will coordinate with Parks and Rec.
- It was determined to have a Club Spring Fly-In June 5. The rain date is June 12. The Club will provide all the goodies and eats.
- 6. A date for a Club Picnic will be decided close to September.

SAFETY REPORT....Bob Walker, Safety Officer

Spring is definitely here. Let's just hope there is not a relapse back to winter. I am writing this Sunday the 21st and it was pretty drab at the field today; trees are still bare.....but absolutely beautiful for flying. There were a number of new planes and helicopters at the field today. And more people have switched to 2.4 gHz radios. We definitely need to get a few more pins for the 2.4 gHz radios since that is the trend. It may have been a few months since you have flown, so let's go over a few basics. Everyone will not be happy with these, but if you think about it, these simple things can make it a little safer out there. I noticed that very few people stand behind the "Pilot Station" signs along the fence. A lot of people fly from the openings in the fence. Over the years we have seen many planes fly through the openings....unintended of course. The fence may not be much, but is an extra barrier to protect you. Please fly from behind the fence.

Everyone needs to get back in the habit of using a frequency pin, even if you are on 2.4 gHz. The reason many clubs have the pin rule is twofold:

1) it may cause you to think a little more as to what radio you brought to the field. 2.4 gHz flyers sometimes still bring an older 72 mHz radio to the field. If you are used to just flipping on the 2.4 transmitter, having the proper pin with 72 may prevent you from shooting down someone. 2) Our agreement with the county is that all flyers are members of AMA for the insurance. Without putting a card in the slot, you, us, no one, has any idea who is an AMA member. Remember, you can be in the club and not have an AMA card. If a stranger is flying are you going to ask if they are in AMA? Probably not, but it is everyone's job to remind people of the card in the slot....that is easier to do. A few other things.....we still have a barrel of airplane hold downs. Most people do use them or one of the wooden carts which were great ideas. Don't taxi out of the pits if someone

is along the line flying. They can hear an airplane coming, but not see it without taking their eyes off a flying plane. Finally and sort of on the same subject, please respect the pilots flying the planes. They should be concentrating 100% on flying. I was not there, but I heard another plane went down due to a spectator talking to the pilot who lost concentration. Until next month....fly safe and have fun....
