
### **GENERAL CLUB NEWS...**



# John Kocon Jr.

John Kocon Jr. of Bel Air died Feb. 12 at Upper Chesapeake Medical Center in Bel Air. He was 76.

Born Dec. 6, 1929 in Baltimore, he was the son of the late John Kocon Sr. and the late Anna Drost Kocon. He was the husband of Rita L. Becker Kocon.

He was a machine operator for Lucent Technologies for 35 years. He served in the Army in the Korean and Vietnam wars where he received one Bronze Star, a Korean Service Medal with two Bronze Stars, United Nations Service Medal and a Merit Unit Third Commendation.

## SAFETY REPORT....Bob Walker, Safety Officer

There is probably not a lot of flying going on right now. But hopefully, everyone is building away or working on their ARFs, waiting for the first sign of Spring. So, let's review some things you may be involved in doing right now and keep your plane from crashing. There is a tidal wave of buying the 2.4 gHz radios. The manufacturers have less and less to sell on 72 mHz. The majority of people are buying the Spektrum radio systems. And they are included with many of the foam electrics. Here are some things Spektrum recommends. Most apply to the Airtronics, Futabas and HiTec;s too.

#### Do:

- \*Perform a range check before each flight Stay relatively close your first flight
- \*Spread receivers apart in the plane (Airtronics, antennas at 90 degrees)
- \*Use a second battery for valuable aircraft
- \*Point your TX antenna vertical.
- \*Use Quality servos

#### Don't:

- \*Use any amplified Y-harness.....this is different from 72 Mhz
- \*Use old batteries
- \*Cut off or change antennas
- \*Use electronic reversing Y's.....again, different from 72 mHz
- \*Point transmitter antenna at the aircraft Be prepared to fly safe!!!
