## SAFETY REPORT....Bob Walker, Safety Officer

Two topics this month:

1. I was not there, but I heard a plane went in over the weekend due to an antenna not being raised. This was a 72 MHz radio, of course. I don't know if the person has both 72 and 2.4, but it just goes back to thinking before taking off. With so many on 2.4, it is difficult to notice if someone is flying with an antenna down or has a 2.4 transmitter.

2. Li-Po Batteries: We have discussed these before, but I keep reading stories about fires. There are some new Li-Po bags that are in the \$10-20 range. I will research these batteries some more and will revisit in a future column. But for now, please remember that these remain a potential fire hazard. I would not charge inside a car and walk away, nor charge somewhere in the house unattended. Any battery that looks puffed out should be disposed of in a proper manner. There was a photo in Model Aviation last year of a van that caught on fire from Li-Po's being charged.

Li-Po batteries should only be charged with a charger that is specifically designed for that type battery. And unlike NiCads (TM) and NiMH batteries, Li-Po's should be removed from the charger once at full charge.

With all the electrics using Li-Po's, and having incredible power, these batteries are going to be more and more common.
