SAFETY REPORT...BY Bob Walker

It's that time of the year to pick out what you really want for Christmas. That shiny new airplane would be really neat, but how about some things to keep you safe or prevent a crash of your plane. I am sure you can think of plenty more, but here is a list to get you started:

- A Lipo bag to store your lipo batteries. Even if you have one, you know you added a bunch more batteries since last year
- A real battery charger so you can check the capacity of your batteries. How much capacity does that 2000 mAh battery really have? You might be surprised if you have not checked
- New batteries. If you have no idea how old your batteries are, you probably need to replace them. The pros replace their batteries every other year as it is not worth a plane crash.
- Safety glasses. There are plenty of cool ones out there at reasonable prices
- Still don't have that first aid kit in the car or truck? You know you are going to cut your finger sooner or later.
- Winter is a great time to buy sunscreen as it is usually on sale
- Have a hard to start engine? How about an electric starter....or at least a heavy glove.
- Instead of charging your lipo batteries in your car, get a deep discharge 12V battery and charge away from your car. Or better yet, get that Honda generator you always wanted.
- Propellers should be balanced before use. A prop balancer is a must and not that expensive
- Speaking of balancing, how about a gizmo to check the center of gravity (CG) of your plane. Many people use the spar as a balance point or just figure the plane must be OK out of the box, but a tail heavy plane is doomed to crash. I don't know of any major safety issues at the field this year, so good job and let 2014 be another trouble free year.
