The annual Christmas Party in December took the place of the regular monthly club meeting so there wasn't any meeting minutes to review or approve. As usual, the Christmas Party was a great success and the attending members and their guests had a great time. See the December 2022 newsletter for more information on the party.

The Board is optimistically looking forward to another great year of flying and comradery at the flying field. The field is in great shape from all the improvements made last year and years prior. We are truly spoiled at the Swan Harbor RC flying field so come out and enjoy yourselves this year and make some new memories and friends. Guests are always welcome to visit the field and watch you fly so take advantage of the great opportunity we all have to enjoy this great hobby.

The winter months are a great time to take a hard look at your RC aircraft & equipment and make necessary repairs, upgrades, and/or replacements. It is also very important to check all of your batteries since they do not last forever. Remember to put your LIPO batteries in the "Storage Charge" mode to help them last as long as possible. There are plenty of articles on the Swan Harbor RC website in the <u>TECH Section</u> to give you some assistance with a lot of RC procedures and explanations.

If you have not been out to the field in a while you will be amazed at how great the runway and pit grass looks. The club has put a lot of effort and resources into making the grass better each year. Also, you will recognize a new pit and flight line fence that is second to none. Not only has the Board done a great job managing our limited resources but with help from the county and our consistent membership, upwards to 80+ members, has made it possible for all of the improvements to be carried out.

On January 4, 2023 at 7:30pm Steve coordinated the first Board meeting of 2023 to welcome the new members and to layout his plan for the coming year. He is trying to develop a good working relationship with Board members and regular members alike.

Lastly, the Board strongly encourages and really appreciates member attendance at the monthly club meetings. The Board wants to make sure that the club is doing things that make flying at the Swan Harbor RC field enjoyable, fun, and safe for you and our guests!

Old Business from 2022:

The Canopy concrete project is coming this spring. As noted at prior meetings in 2022, the county will be working to install concrete under each canopy, a sidewalk between the canopies, and a concrete pad on the outer sides of each canopy. We will provide more details as they become available. This will be done at no cost to the club.

Membership & Treasury:

• <u>Membership</u>:

At the meeting, Steve Snyder reminded members that we ended 2022 with 82 members. So far for 2023 we have 48 renewed members with 34 members yet to renew their membership. Just a quick reminder that the 2023 dues renewal deadline is March 31, 2023. We hope to see all members return for another strong year, so until then, we thank you for your 2022 membership.

Treasury:

Steve Snyder provided an update on how the SHRC finances ended for 2022 and that we are in great shape heading into 2023. The club does not publish financial information in the newsletter or website. New Business for 2023:

Review of 2023 club budget:

Steve presented a 2023 budget for the club. As noted, the club does not publish financial information in newsletters. The Budget includes the following categories:

• Estimated income by source and expenses such as AMA annual recharter, Havre de Grace Rec Committee, Go Daddy web, tractor supplies, club parties, grass maintenance, field maintenance, miscellaneous (weather station).

• New internet accessible weather station:

Steve presented information regarding a new weather station purchased for the field to be installed by early spring. The weather station can be accessed by members via the internet with 8 various services. The station will provide information about wind, temperature, sun radiation (cloudy, partly cloudy, etc.) plus other features. It will not be set up to provide video due to the internet usage cost. Steve is looking to get internet service through Straight Talk (2GB/month for about \$15/month) on a pay as you go basis. The internet device will be installed in the shed and the weather station mast will be mounted to the shed on a grounded pole 2-3 feet above the shed roof. The weather station monitor may be mounted in the bulletin board. The internet access will be locked down to the weather station only. Steve advised the weather station's cost was approximately \$360 on a holiday sale.

• Monthly club meeting venue update:

Due to various issues like inclement weather, heat, low member attendance, etc., all 2023 club meetings will be held at the Havre de Grace Activity Center on Lewis Lane at 7:00pm, on the 2nd Tuesday of each month except for events that take the place of monthly meetings. When meetings get cancelled, the food and supplies purchased for the meetings either get spoiled or are required to be kept longer than their expiration dates. No food will be served at the HDG center.

• 2023 SHRC club events (no rain dates):

- Saturday, June 10, 2023: Open House Fun Fly
- Saturday, September 16, 2023: Open House Fun Fly/Picnic
- Saturday, December 2, 2023: <u>Annual Christmas Party</u>

<u>Note 1</u>: Dale Davis will work with the Harford County Aegis paper to get an article on the club to entice spectators from the area to visit the club during our events. This should be good visibility for our club.

<u>Note 2</u>: Food served at the 2023 club events will be the same fare as in 2022, hamburgers, bag of chips, cookies, a drink, and simple condiment fixings.

Discussion Topics:

• People parking at SHRC gate entrance:

 Dale and several members mentioned that at times people park at the club's front gate entrance when they come to the field. Please be aware you may see this when you come to the field so just ask the person(s) to move so you can enter the field. Dale will look into installing a sign to help deter people from parking at the entrance.

• Safety Tip from Stanley Dill, Safety Officer:


Stan would like to remind members to stop and look for low flying aircraft before you cross

prevent an incident if a plane is on final for landing and is too low.



New Membership Dues:


Full year new membership: \$130.00


Joining period: 1/1/YR thru 12/31/YEAR (*)

Includes \$80.00 annual membership & \$50.00 first year initiation fee

(*) Note: New members joining the club on 9/1/YR or after in that same year are considered paid in full for the remainder of the year and the immediately following year. The reason for this exception is that the current flying season is about 75% over and we want to give new members an incentive to join our club.
