Steve's October Updates

Membership & Treasury Report

<u>Membership</u>: Steve's membership update for the year through October is holding at 82 members. As the year is progressing along we have been slowly adding members to our roster. When RC flyers see our field and the various amenities they are excited about joining the club. We welcome all new members and hope they enjoy what Swan Harbor RC has to offer.

<u>Treasury</u>: Steve discussed the club's financial status. The club is in good financial standing for this time of the year. We are approaching membership renewal at the end of the year which will provide new funds for 2022.

Grass & Mower Maintenance

<u>Grass Update</u>: Steve advised that he is seeing grass emerging in the select areas that 4Evergreen aerated and overseeded in September 2021. The hope is that the two overseeding treatments applied last year and this year will hold up for several years to come before needing another round of overseeding treatments. We need some additional rain showers to help the new grass seed grow before the weather turns cold.

<u>Mower Maintenance</u>: Steve mentioned that we will be getting the three Zero-Turn mowers serviced at the end of the grass cutting season. Stanley Dill will be pressure washing the three mowers and picnic tables. Noting earlier this year, Stan also pressure washed both sheds. Walter G. Coales, Inc. will be servicing the new mower since it was purchased from Coales earlier this year and is still under warranty. New blades and maintenance supplies will be purchased as needed.

Show & Tell:


- Steve and Dale brought Dale's new airplane set up with an RC skydiver named "Steven."

Tech Talk:

- Ron & Steve presented this month's Tech Talk.
- The goal of the Tech Talk discussion is to share information that we have learned over the years and help new and old RC flyers alike. It is only through the sharing of technical information that we can learn new things, enjoy the hobby and be successful.
- There is a tab on the SHRC website called "<u>Tech Section</u>" where you can read articles written about a variety of RC topics.

Presentation & Discussion - Battery Charging, Care & Use:

- Charging batteries:
 - Balance charging vs straight charging.
 - Correct chemistry (LIPO, LIFE, A123, Li-ION, NIMH, NICD).
 - Charge rate of 1C (formula: MAH ÷ 1000 = 1C.)
 - Correct # cells.
 - Use LIPO safe charging bag or container in the house.
 - Storage charging LIPO batteries: reduces battery voltage to 40% for long term stability of battery cells.
 - Charging is the most dangerous time for issues do it right.
- Internal Resistance (IR):
 - A very good way to check the battery's health.
 - Newer chargers have this feature.
 - LIPO IR Health Ratings:
 - 1-10 great
 - 11-15 good
 - 15-20 poor
 - Above 20, the battery should be considered for replacement.
 - Track IR over life of battery to see its performance loss.
 - Check IR same way each time with the same cables.
 - Will help alleviate a battery failure in flight or during charging.

Watt Meters:

- A Watt Meter is a precision RC volt and amp meter.
- Analyzes electric plane configuration (Motor, ESC, Battery, and Model Performance).
- Key Readings: Peak Watts (PW) & Peak Amps (PA):
 - <u>Peak Watts</u> Tells if motor is achieving manufacturer's rated peak Watts:
 - Good to know manufacturer's specs for comparison & verification.
 - Tells If prop's pitch/diameter is correctly matched for its Peak Watts.
 - May need to change the prop to get correct Peak Watts.
 - Think of this as using a Tachometer on a Gas/Glow engine.


- <u>Peak Amps</u> Tells if ESC/Battery amperage capacity matches motor amperage draw:
 - Is ESC rated and matched for peak motor amperage draw:
 - ESC amperage rating should be 10-20% higher than motor amperage draw.
 - Is Battery capacity matched for combined motor and ESC peak amperage draw.
 - Battery should support the amperage draw of ESC & Motor at full power.
 - Motor's Peak Amps draw:
 - Formula: Motor's total watts ÷ battery voltage
 - Meter reading: Watt meter reading for Peak Amps
 - A battery's continuous Peak Amps output equals:
 - Battery MAH x C-Rating ÷ 1000 .

During the Tech Talk discussion Warren Dieffenbach and Bob Walker offered additional tips on equipment they are using for charging and discharging their batteries:

- Warren said he's using the Kacallap a12 LiPo Battery Smart Discharger to discharge his LiPo batteries and put them into <u>Storage</u> mode, which is approximately 40% of a full charge.
 - He said it works very well and is quick. Regular chargers take a long time to put batteries into storage.
 - Check it out. \$79.99.




- Bob said he's been using the Spektrum Smart S2100 AC Charger for his LiPo batteries:

 - This charger has many high-tech features and can be operated in a fully automatic mode as follows:
 - Preset charge, discharge, and storage parameters are automatically relayed from your Spektrum Smart Battery making charging as simple as pressing the "Start" button. Charge rate of individual batteries can be user customized allowing you to take full advantage of packs with faster charge ratings. The integrated microchip on each battery will remember the last charging rate you set, so the next time you plug it in, these settings will automatically populate so all you have to do is press "Start."

Bob Walker sent in this photo taken of a low flying military plane that came right over the Swan Harbor farmhouse and then made a left turn into the Philips Airfield. This is a good reminder to be aware of low flying aircraft flying over the Swan Harbor RC flying field. Keep in mind that our RC aircraft flying ceiling is 400 feet above the ground.

Always practice safe flying!
