## <u>Tech Corner</u>: "Work Space" Article submitted by Bob Bartell

I don't have much workspace in my basement. As my first solution, I built a table and attached it to the studs with hinges so I could fold the table up out of the way (as you can see it in the back of the pictures below). However, besides always being in the way, it was difficult to get to the other side of the plane. Picking the plane up and turning it around is a sure way for me to create hangar rash. So, I bought a tool cart from Harbor Freight and made some adjustable fuselage holders for each end. This worked great for medium sized planes but not so much for larger planes.



To accommodate larger planes, I used a tool cabinet adjacent to the tool cart.

This gives me more room for larger planes, more storage, and more options for moving things around If you have limited space like I do, this solution may help you out.
