

TivoCFR is a wifi remote control for Tivo DVRs. It is a fully functional remote on both iPhone and Apple Watch. The app breaks the Tivo remote into 4 pages. Swipe left and right to page through the different sections of the remote.

TivoCFR is free to download. After download, the app is usable for Page1 functions only. In “initial” state use iPhone app to:

- Discover Tivo devices.
- Send Devices to Apple Watch.
- Change settings.
- Send Settings to the Apple Watch.
- Test functions before getting trial or purchasing.

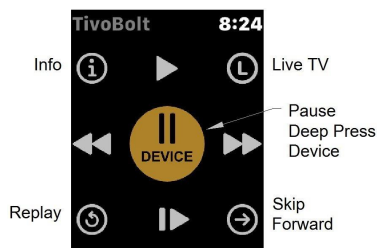

Features:

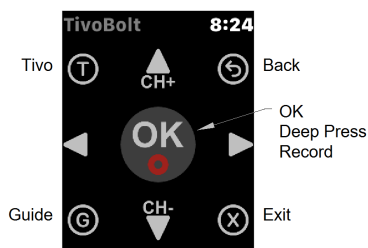
- The Apple Watch app is totally independent of the iPhone app¹. Deep press the Pause/Device button to switch Tivo devices.
- All Settings, Device discovery and Purchases are handled by the iPhone app.
- Quick Play - (Apple Watch app only). Used when fast forwarding or rewinding. The Tivo device returns to play state the next time the watch is activated².
- Grid Display - Turn on Grid Display to see how the grid fits iPhone or Apple Watch.

General Usage:

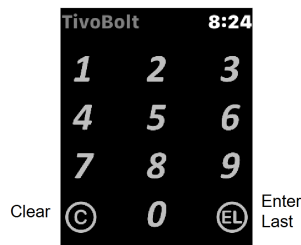
Most of the functionality of the remote (both iPhone and Watch OS) is straight forward with a few exceptions illustrated below:



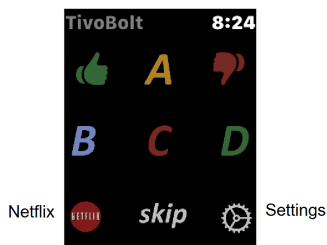

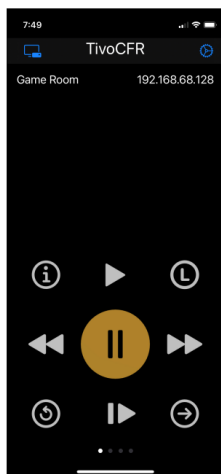

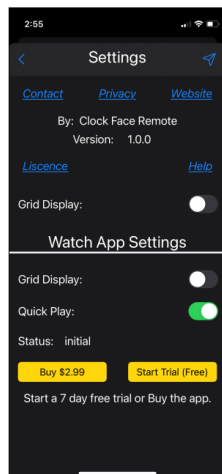

Initial Setup:

TivoCFR uses network control so please make sure that all of your Tivo devices allow network-based remotes. Go to Tivo > Settings > Remote > “Allow network-based remotes”. Refer to your Tivo documentation for further help.

For best experience, setup the iPhone and Apple Watch App together:

Check operation of the Page 1 functions on iPhone and Apple Watch apps.

After the initial setup is complete, go to Settings to start a free 7 day trial and unlock the full 4 page functionality of the app. After the 7 day trial is complete, the app will return to the limited Page1 functionality similar to the initial state. Continue using the app in this limited state or go back to Settings to purchase the app and unlock the full 4 page functionality.

Please note:

- The app can be purchased at any time before, during or after the trial period.
- If the app is ever reloaded, go to Settings to restore the Purchase status. If the app is purchased, full rights will be automatically restored. If the app was in trial mode, the remaining time will be restored.

1. Due to limitations of Apple Watch Wi-Fi, the iPhone will still need to be on and connected to your watch. The iPhone app does not need to be open for the Apple Watch app to function. The iPhone app is used for all settings, Tivo device discovery, and purchases.
2. Quick Play is a convenience feature that may be turned off in the iPhone app settings. Since Tivo devices have no feedback during fast forward or rewind, the Apple Watch app has no way of knowing the mode of the Tivo DVR. The play command will be sent the next time the watch is activated. This may not be ideal at times such as when the DVR reaches live tv during fast forward.
3. If your Tivo Devices aren't showing in the table, press the DISCOVER button. Check the list of Tivo Devices. If any are missing press the ADD button and add Name and IP address manually.
