



## Paper Airplanes

### Construction

- 30 minutes will be provided for competitors to fold, decorate, and test their planes
  - Markers will be provided in this time period
  - Each plane **must have the competitors first and last name** legibly written on it.
  - Competitors are advised to refrain from inappropriate designs.
- Competitors will be provided 8.5" x 11" paper to construct as many airplanes as they would like.
- The plane must have a body from which the competitor can hold the plane, in addition to 2 or more wings.
  - Paper balls, circular gliders are not allowed

### Competition

- Each competitor will be given **3 flights**.
- 3 timers will time the flight, and the middle (Median) of the 3 times will be recorded as the official flight time.
- **Competitors are not allowed to run while inside the gym as it creates air currents.**
- In order to qualify for the most artistic award, competitors must turn their planes over to the event supervisor after their flights for judging.

### Scoring

- The competitor's final score will be the **highest** of the 3 official flight times.
- The competitor with the highest final score wins
- In the event of a tie, the next highest flight time will be used

### Awards

- 1st Place - Flight Time
- 2nd Place - Flight Time
- 3rd Place - Flight Time
- 1st Place - Most Artistic
