

Amsterdam Girl Killed by Train; Sister Escapes

Fatality Occurs as Pair Walk Along Track

AMSTERDAM, Aug. 28.—As her four-year-old sister looked helplessly on, Frances Grecco, 14, 310 East Main street, was killed instantly here today by an east-bound passenger train.

The smaller child, Theresa, who tried to jump, was struck and knocked down by Frances' body. She is in City hospital, and is expected to recover.

Mr. and Mrs. Anthony Grecco are the parents of the girls.

Frances was killed as she was walking with her sister along the tracks in the same direction as the train in which the train was traveling, according to a police report of the fatality.

Police say that inasmuch as the train did not stop, the engineer probably did not know he had hit the children.

Authorities were notified of the accident by Robert Stewart, an employee of a nearby garage, who saw the children lying in the roadbed after the train had passed. Police called an ambulance.

When it arrived, the older girl was dead. The body was removed to the hospital, however, where an autopsy will be performed, under direction of Coroner Thomas Monaghan.

Hospital authorities said X-rays will be employed to determine the extent of the younger girl's injuries. She is bruised considerably about the body, and there is a possibility of internal injuries, it was said at the hospital.
