- Itrust in thee O LORD, you are my God. (Psalm 31:14)
- I know where my help comes from. My help comes from the LORD, maker of heaven and earth. (PSALM 121:2)
- I am like an olive tree growing in the house of God. I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever. I will praise and give thanks to you forever and ever. (Psalm 52:8-9)
- O LORD, who is like thee? You are mighty and your faithfulness surrounds you. (Psalm 89:8)

- Because of the <u>BLOOD OF JESUS</u>: I have been redeemed! All my sins are forgiven! All my sins are washed away! Though my sins be as scarlet, they shall be white as snow! (see Ephesians 1:7, Revelation 1:5, etc.)
- Because of the BLOOD OF JESUS: I have eternal life! (see John 3:16,17:1-3; Romans 6:23, etc.)
- Because of the BLOOD OF JESUS: I can come boldly before the throne of grace to get grace to help in time of need! All grace abounds unto me that I might have all sufficiency in all things! (see Hebrews 4:16, 2 COR 9:8)
- Because of the BLOOD OF JESUS: God shows Himself strong on my behalf! (see 2 CHRON 16:9)

- Blessed be the LORD, day by day He bears our burdens, even the God who is our salvation. God is unto us a God of deliverance, the LORD delivers us from death. (Psalm 68:19-20)
- Your righteousness is like the mighty mountains Father, your justice is like the great deep. You preserve both man and beast.
- You are continually with me Father, you hold me by my right hand. You guide me with your counsel and afterward, you will take me into glory. Whom do I have in heaven but you Father? There is none I desire besides thee O LORD! My flesh and heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever. (Psalm 73:23-26)
- God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Even if the earth is shaken and the mountains fall into the sea, we will not fear. (Psalm 46:1-3)

Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth. Burst into jubilant song with music and rejoice and sing praises. Sing unto the LORD with musical instruments and voices of psalmists, shout for joy before the LORD, the King. Let the sea roar and the fullness thereof, and the whole world and all that dwell in it. Let the rivers clap their hands, let the hills and mountains be joyful before the LORD, for he comes to judge the earth. With righteousness he will judge the world and the people with equity. (Psalm 98)
- Father, you are a God full of compassion and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness. (Psalm 86:15)
- The LORD is good. His love is everlasting. And his truth endures through all generations. (Psalm 100:5)
- Father, in the presence of my enemies, you prepare a table for me. You anoint my head with oil and my cup overflows. (Psalm 23:5)
- Just as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, so also through Christ comfort abounds in us. (2 Corinthians 1:5)
- Among the gods there is none like you O LORD. No deeds can compare with your deeds. All the nations which you have made Father will come and worship before you and glorify your name. You are great and do wondrous things—you alone are God. (Psalm 86:8-10)

- Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endures through all generations. (Psalm 145:13)
- Praise the LORD. Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good and His love endures forever. (Psalm 106:1)
- Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ. In love, He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world that we should be holy and blameless before Him. Our Father predestined us to be the adopted children of Jesus Christ, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, which made us accepted in the beloved. In Jesus we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of our Father's grace, which He lavishes upon us. With all wisdom and understanding, He made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure and purpose, that in the fullness of time, God might gather together in one all things in Christ, both the things in the heavens and the things upon the earth. - Hear us O Shepherd of Israel, you who leads Joseph like a flock, you who sit enthroned upon the cherubim, shine forth.
 Stir up your might before Ephraim and Benjamin and Manasseh and come to save us. O God, restore us and cause thy face to shine upon us and we shall be saved. (Psalm 80:1-3)
- Keep not thy silence O God, hold not thy peace, be not still O God. For thy enemies make an uproar, they that hate thee riot against thee. They have taken up crafty counsel against thy people and consulted against thy treasured ones. They have said "Come, let us cut them off from being a nation, that the name of Israel may be remembered no more". They are united against you O God! (Psalm 83:1-6)
- O my God, make your enemies like the whirling dust, like tumbleweed before the wind. As fire consumes the forest, as flames set mountains ablaze, pursue your enemies with your tempest and terrify them with your storms O LORD. Fill their

faces with shame that they may seek your name. Let them be ashamed and frightened. Yea, let them be ashamed and perish, that they may know that it is you alone, whose name is the LORD, who is Most High over all the earth. (Psalm 83:13-18)

- Your hand will grab hold of your enemies, your right hand will seize your foes and make them like a fiery furnace in thy fierce wrath O LORD in the time of your anger. You will swallow them up in your wrath and devour them in the fire. You will destroy their fruit from the earth, their seed from among the children of men. (Psalm 21:8-10)
- Our God comes and will not be silent. A fire devours before him, a tempest rages around him. He will summon the heavens above and the earth below, that he may judge his people.
 "Gather my saints together unto me, those that made a covenant with me by sacrifice". And the heavens shall declare his righteousness, for God himself is judge. (Psalm 50:3-6)
- Let God arise, let His enemies be scattered. Let those that hate
 Him flee before Him. As smoke is driven away, so drive them
 away. As wax melts before the fire, so let the wicked perish at the
 presence of God. But let the righteous be glad and rejoice before
 God. (Psalm 68:1-3)
- The righteous will rejoice when they see your vengeance, when they bathe their feet in the blood of the wicked. Men will say "surely the righteous are rewarded, surely there is a God that judges in the earth". (Psalm 58:10-11)
- Multitudes upon multitudes shall be in the valley of decision, for the DAY OF THE LORD is near in the valley of decision. The sun and moon will be darkened and the stars will withdraw their

The LORD will roar from Zion and utter his voice from Jerusalem and the heavens and the earth will shake, but the LORD will be the hope of His people, and the strength of of the children of Israel. So shall ye know that I am the LORD your God dwelling in Zion, my holy mountain. Then shall Jerusalem be holy and no strangers shall pass through her any more. (Joel 3:14-17)

- You O LORD, sit enthroned forever, and your renown endures through all generations Father. You will arise and have compassion upon Zion, for it is time to be gracious to her, for the appointed time has come. For your servants take pleasure in her stones and love her dust. The nations will fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth will revere your glory. When the LORD builds up Zion, He will appear in his glory. (Psalm 102:12-16)
- O LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel, arouse yourself to punish all the nations, show no mercy to wicked traitors. (Psalm 59:5)
- Arise, O LORD, <u>let not man prevail</u>, <u>let the nations be judged in your sight</u>. Strike fear and terror into the nations O LORD, let them know that they are but men. (Psalm 9:19-20)
- Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they also which pierced him: and all peoples of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, amen. (Revelation 1:7)

THY WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN

- Father, be gracious unto us and bless us. Cause your face to shine upon us so that your ways may be known upon the earth and your salvation known amongst the nations. (Psalm 67:1-2)
- Father of glory, may you give me the spirit of wisdom and revelation that I may know you better. May the eyes of my understanding be enlightened, that I may know the hope of your calling on my life and the riches of the glory of the inheritance of the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of your power to us who believe, according to the working of your mighty power which you wrought in Christ when you raised him from the dead and set him at your right hand in heavenly places, far above every principality, power, might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but the world which is to come. (Ephesians 1:17-21)
- Father, show me your ways. Teach me your paths. Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation, in you I hope all the day long. (Psalm 25:4-5)
- Father, may you fill me with the knowledge of your will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding. (Colossians 1:9)
- Send forth your light and truth Father, let them lead me and bring me unto your holy mountain, the place where you dwell. (Psalm 43:3)
- I stand firm with the belt of truth around my waist, and with the breastplate of righteousness, and with feet fitted with the preparation of the gospel of peace. And above all, I take up the shield of faith with which I quench all the fiery darts of the Devil. And I put on the helmet of salvation and take up the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. (Ephesians 6:14-17)

GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD

- Satisfy us in the morning with your unfailing love, that we may sing for joy and be glad all our days. (Psalm 90:14)
- Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts: And see if there be any way in me that is grievous (to the Holy Spirit), and lead me in the way everlasting. (Psalm 139:23-24)

Add any Scriptures that touch your heart and you wish to add here and then, at this point in your prayers, present your petitions before God your Father. Jesus said ask all things so your joy may be complete. Whatsoever you ask the Father He will give you if you remain in Jesus. So put anything and everything in the hands of your Father who art in heaven and trust in Him for it all.

But also remember this: the Father knows you need to pay the bills and you need food to eat and clothes to wear and this, that, and the other thing. Seek ye first the kingdom of God and all these things, and everything else you will ever need, will be taken care of by your Father who art in heaven who loves you and has your destiny in His hands. You don't even have to ask for these things if your soul's sole aim is the kingdom of God. When your soul's sole aim is the kingdom of God, the Most High will move heaven and earth to pave the way before you and bring you along the pathway He has chosen for you. The Most High will fill every valley before you. Every mountain and hill will be brought low before you. Crooked ways will be made straight before you. Rough ways will be made smooth before you (see LUKE 3:5). And in so doing, along the way, do you think the Most High will not also pay the bills for you?

So let your asking focus on things of the kingdom. And pray for your family members and ask God to help you juggle everything in your life, whatever those things are for you, and to process it all and put it all into God's hands and trust in Him for it all, to make everything work out for you in the end.

FORGIVE US OUR TRESPASSES AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US

 When you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive him, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins. (Mark 11:25)

LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL

- Order my steps by your word, let not any iniquity have dominion over me. (Psalm 119:133)
- Who can discern his own errors? <u>Cleanse me Father from my hidden faults</u>. <u>Keep me, your servant, from willful sins</u>, let them not have dominion over me. Then I shall be upright, innocent from great transgression. Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable before you, O LORD, my Rock, and my Redeemer. (Psalm 19:12-14)

Remember this admonition from Paul:

 Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God. (2 Corinthians 7:1)

- Praise the LORD. Praise the LORD from the heavens, praise him in the heights. Praise him all his angels, praise him all heavenly hosts. Praise him sun and moon, praise him all you stars. Praise him in the highest heavens, and you waters above the heavens. Let them praise the name of the LORD, for he commanded and they were created. He established them forever and ever. He has made a decree that shall not pass away. Praise the LORD from the earth, all you sea creatures and ocean depths, lightning and hail, snow and clouds, stormy winds that do his bidding, mountains and all hills, fruit trees and all cedars, beasts and cattle and creeping things and flying birds, kings of the earth and all people, princes and all judges of the earth, young men and maidens, old men and children, let them all praise the name of the LORD, for his name alone is exalted. His glory is above the earth and heaven. He has exalted the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints, even of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise the LORD. (Psalm 148)
