Teacher Support Committee Update

A new committee was formed earlier this year by a few parents who simply wanted to show additional support, to be “cheer leaders” for the teachers, and to provide assistance where needed since Room Parents are not an option right now. They call themselves the Teacher Support Committee (TSC).

So far this school year...

- In October, the TSC sent out a request for donations to a Teacher Appreciation Fund, and they were overwhelmed with the generosity of fellow parents who also wanted to show appreciation in this way. Using a portion of the funds collected, the TSC **purchased various gift cards from local businesses** and each of the teachers and support staff of CKCS received one along with a sincere **Thank You note** just before Thanksgiving. “We wanted them to know how truly thankful we are for their additional efforts and flexibility right now” said Brandis Wasvick, a member of the TSC.

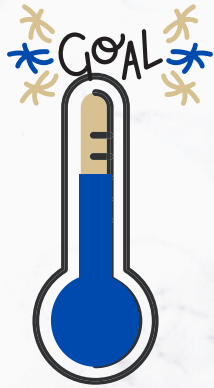

- PASS Curriculum Update -

CKCS is committed to building strong learning skills and broad-based knowledge by integrating effective traditional and contemporary teaching methods to create a dynamic learning environment for all students. Pursuant to its commitment to families, CKCS is piloting a new math program called Math Expressions this year, which, if approved by the CKCS Curriculum Committee and Governing Council, will have a very large purchase (>\$50,000) on our horizon. While we are working with the district to cover some of the per student costs as a public school, VASD contributions are not guaranteed. PASS is excited to support the commitment of CKCS by fundraising towards this significant purchase. Giving Tuesday raised \$805 through the generous donations of CKCS families. We have a long way to go. Keep an eye out for updates on the impact of your Giving Tuesday donation in the coming months, along with other ways to get involved in the CKCS community.
