A 2-1 matching grant was received from the Madison Community Foundation. We are working at raising \$60,000 in 18 months. \$26000 has already been raised. There will be a fundraising dance 4/6 at the American Legion in Verona, the theme is "Under the Stars".

IV. Director's Report (Rick)

Rick and Nicole have a conference call with Lake Country Academy in Sheboygan, they use the Core Knowledge Sequence and use Direct Instruction. The goal is to learn about each other's programs and share ideas of how to improve our school.

Budget: no major updates, Rick will be talking with PRT about future school-year needs.

Enrollment: 416 students, 3 new students are moving in so the total will be 419 by the end of February.

Hiring Committee: a special education assistant position interviews were held. This is a combined position with BRMS and CKCS. The recommendation is to hire Melinda Kerl for this position, she is currently a custodian at CKCS and BRMS. This is a district hire.

Upcoming Dates: Jan. 10 Incoming Kindergarten Night

Board briefs: A committee has discussed being able to have a second option for a choice school, the board will be discussing this.

Referendum: Site layout, playground areas are being worked on, not yet finalized.

 - A. Dialogue teacher feedback on IXL, Discovery Science (Nicole)

Staff did a survey regarding IXL. Most classes are using IXL 4-5 days/week. 81% of staff wanted to see IXL available as a resource for another 3-5 years. The IXL contract expires May 2020.

There was also a staff survey for Discovery Streaming and Discovery Science Techbook. These are tools to enhance the science curriculum. Discovery Streaming is provided from the district. The Discovery Science Techbook is rarely being used. Discovery Science Techbook expires Spring 2022. We don't recommend purchasing Discovery Science Techbook after the contract expires.
