## I. Reading of the CKCS Mission Statement

**COVID Update** - Positive cases of COVID for both students and staff are decreasing.

Swimming Update - Swimming units will resume on February 21 and run through April 15. Core Knowledge swimming will be at the Natatorium and will occur in the afternoons. Students will wear masks to/from swimming as well in the locker rooms. Students will not wear masks in the pool area and will remain physically distanced when unmasked.

**Elementary Music Concert Update** - CKCS will plan for a modified in-person concert this spring, likely sometime in April.

**Enrollment Request Update** - Looking ahead to next academic year, we have 60 openings (40 of which are in kindergarten). As of today, we have 25 applicants for kindergarten. We would like a minimum of 30 students in the kindergarten class. The charter/choice application deadline is mid-February. Families can enroll after the deadline as a late applicant and will be placed based on availability.

Calendar Request to the District - The two CKCS PD days for next year will be submitted to the district. These days will be November 22, 2022 (day before the district Thanksgiving break) and February 16, 2023 (day before the February District PD day), following the same pattern as recent years.

**Eighth Grade Promotion Policy** - GC members will review the proposed 8th Grade Promotion Criteria and vote at an upcoming meeting on this criteria. Once the promotion policy has been approved by GC, it will be added to the Family Handbook.

iPad Use - Current iPad use varies from classroom to classroom. In some classrooms, tablets are used more frequently than in the past (pre-COVID). Some teachers have become very comfortable with Seesaw and are using it more readily. CKCS continuously monitors apps that are being used for educational value and safety. New apps will be added if their purpose aligns with instructional goals. Elementary students (grades 2-5) still use paper planners and these will still be utilized for the foreseeable future. Middle School students may request a paper planner but many students are comfortable/prefer using Canvas or other digital planners.

**VASD Board meeting update** - Board discussions continue to focus on the projected zero dollar per pupil increase from the state for school districts next year.
